Introduction:

#1 EXPECTING life to heat up 12

12 Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you;

#2 EXALTING when life heats up 13-14

1st Suffering like Christ now, means future REWARD 13

13 but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation.

2nd Suffering like Christ, means supernatural blessing and <u>HELP</u> 14

14 If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.

15 Make sure that none of you suffers as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler; 16 but if anyone suffers as a Christian, he is not to be ashamed, but is to glorify God in this name. 17 For it is time for judgment to begin with the household of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 And if it is with difficulty that the righteous is saved, what will become of the godless man and the sinner? 19 Therefore, those also who suffer according to the will of God shall entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.

#3 E<u>VALUATING</u> as life heats up 15-18

1st Are you suffering for the right REASONS? 15-16

NORMAL suffering DISOBEDIENT suffering RIGHTEOUS suffering

- 1-Not as a CRIMINAL who deserves to be punished 15
- 2-But as a Christian who seeks to GLORIFY God 16

2nd Are you evaluating yourself and your church FIRST? 17-18

1-Focus on your **HEART** and the Church first, not the Lost 17a

Romans 8:1 Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 11:32 But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

Hebrews 12:8 But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons.

2-Compare the difficulty of <u>DISCIPLINE</u> for a Christian now with the certainty of <u>DAMNATION</u> for the lost forever 17b-18

Revelation 20:15 if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Augustine 'If the sons are chastised, what have the most malicious slaves to expect'

Acts 14:22b "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."
